
IMPORTANT 24 HR WATER TEST INSTRUCTIONS




- 1. Plumbing should be inserted 7.5" starting from the rubber baffle.
- 2. Backfill 50 inches deep from bottom of tank all around.
- 3. Plug inlet and outlet AT TANK so tank is isolated from other parts of system.
- 4. Fill tank with water so there is two inches of water in riser. No more, no less.

NOTE: IF YOUR INSPECTION IS ON A MONDAY, FILL TANK TO SEAM AND FILL REMAINDER OF TANK 24 HOURS BEFORE INSPECTION

- 5. Measure the water loss; if there is no water loss during the first 24 hours the test is acceptable.
- 6. More than a one gallon water loss during this time is cause for rejection.

NOTE: IN HOT WEATHER CONCRETE WILL ABSORB WATER, REFILL AND RETEST IF LEVEL DROPS



PIPE SHOULD BE INSERTED 7.5" STARTING FROM THE RUBBER BAFFLE
